

# WEB Statistics

After implementing WEB, these schools experienced the following changes. This list represents a sampling of the types of changes that WEB is having on middle schools across the US and Canada:

## Rogers Middle School, Rogers, Minnesota

- 51% reduction of 6<sup>th</sup> graders with a D or F on their report card

## Valley Middle School, Carlsbad, California

- 93% decrease in 6<sup>th</sup> grade suspensions
- 61% decrease in 6<sup>th</sup> graders with Ds or Fs
- 63% decrease in 6<sup>th</sup> grade tardies
- 75% decrease in 6<sup>th</sup> grade referrals

## KLO Middle School, Kelowna, British Columbia

- 2/3 of students reported they felt more prepared for school because of WEB
- 20% increase in overall parent satisfaction with the school

## Westlake Middle School, Broomfield, Colorado

### Number of bullying incidents

- 2001: 12 (before WEB)
- 2004: 0
- 2005: 0

### Number of 6<sup>th</sup> grade suspensions

- 2001: 28 (before WEB)
- 2004: 4
- 2005: 0

## Beaumont Middle School, Portland, Oregon

- 7% increase in 6<sup>th</sup> grade attendance

## Five Oaks Middle School, Beaverton, Oregon

- 60% decrease in 6<sup>th</sup> graders with Ds and Fs
- 52% decrease in 6<sup>th</sup> grade absences
- 31% decrease in 6<sup>th</sup> grade tardies

## Orono Middle School, Orono, Minnesota

- 33% reduction in bullying of 6<sup>th</sup> graders
- More than 50% reduction in 6<sup>th</sup> grade disciplinary referrals

## Mill Valley Middle School, Mill Valley, California

- 56% reduction in 6<sup>th</sup> grade students with D's or F's on their report card
- 67% reduction in 6<sup>th</sup> grade suspensions

## Cloquet Middle School, Cloquet, Minnesota

- 42% reduction in 6<sup>th</sup> grade absences
- 39% reduction in 6<sup>th</sup> grade disciplinary referrals

## Redwood South Middle School, ST. Louis, Missouri

- 2006: 30 6<sup>th</sup> grade suspensions
- 2007: 0 6<sup>th</sup> grade suspensions
  
- 63% reduction in 6<sup>th</sup> grade disciplinary referrals
- 50% reduction in 6<sup>th</sup> grade failures

### **Shanahan Middle School, Lewis Center, Ohio**

- 20% reduction in 6<sup>th</sup> grade absences
- 37% reduction in 6<sup>th</sup> grade disciplinary referrals
- 54% reduction in 6<sup>th</sup> grade D's and F's

### **Crestview Middle School, Ellisville, Missouri**

- 46% reduction in 6<sup>th</sup> grade absences
- 68% reduction in 6<sup>th</sup> grade disciplinary referrals

### **Highland Middle School, Bellevue, Washington**

- 73% reduction in 6<sup>th</sup> grade disciplinary referrals
